

PINWHEEL PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

Unless the ground is very soft, it is easiest to "plant" pinwheels by first making a hole in the ground with a large Phillips Head screwdriver that has a long shaft which is 3-4 inches deep. Then insert the stick of the pinwheel and tamp the ground around it to ensure it remains erect. Two people can work in teams - one making the holes and the other planting the pinwheel and tamping the ground.
