HB 253 (Del. Vivian Watts) - Adds a third or subsequent conviction of unlawful dissemination or sale of images of another to the list of offenses requiring registration under the Sex Offender and Crimes Against Minors Registry. https://lis.virginia.gov/cgi-bin/legp604.exe?201+sum+HB253

<u>HB 462 (Del. Rip Sullivan)</u> - Directs the Secretary of Health to establish a task force to study the shortage of certified sexual assault nurse examiners in the Commonwealth. <u>HB 298 (Del. <u>HB 840 (Del. Kathleen Murphy)</u> - Requires health insurers whose plan includes coverage for medicines to classify medically necessary formula and enteral nutrition products as medicine and to include coverage for medically necessary formula and enteral nutrition products for covered individuals requiring treatment for an inherited metabolic disorder. https://lis.virginia.gov/cgi-bin/legp604.exe?201+sum+HB840

<u>HB 861 (Del. Mark Levine)</u> - Provides that any act of violence, force, or threat against an intimate partner or the intimate partner's child or any history of child abuse shall be considered by a court in determining the best interests of a child for the purposes of a custody or visitation arrangement. https://lis.virginia.gov/cgi-bin/legp604.exe?201+sum+HB861

<u>HB 1301 (Del. Chris Hurst)</u> - Establishes the Office of the Children's Ombudsman to provider oversight of the State Department of Social Services, local departments of social services, child-placing agencies, or child-caring institutions; The Office of the Children's Ombudsman is headed by the Children's Ombudsman, who is appointed for a term of four years by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the General Assembly. https://lis.virginia.gov/cgi-bin/legp604.exe?201+sum+HB1301

<u>HB 1544 (Del. Lee Carter)</u> - Provides that no child under the age of 14 shall be strip searched and that a child who is 14 years of age or older but under 18 years of age shall not be strip searched unless such child and such child's parent, guardian, or other person responsible for the care of such child has authorized or consented to the strip search. https://lis.virginia.gov/cgi-bin/legp604.exe?201+sum+HB1544

HB 74 (Del. Kaye Kory) - Requires each school board to (i) adopt and implement policies that require each teacher and other relevant personnel, as determined by the school board, employed on a full-time basis, to complete a mental health awareness training or similar program at least once and (ii) provide such training, which may be provided pursuant to a contract with the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services, a community services board, a behavioral health authority, a nonprofit organization, or other certified trainer or via an online module. https://lis.virginia.gov/cgi-bin/legp604.exe?201+bil+HB0074

<u>HB 1614 (Del.
